Biogenic CO₂ from the combustion of biomass (such as a digester gas that is a bio-gas) is not considered in the emission calculations for determining applicability of the rule. Only CH₄ and N₂O emissions from the combustion of biomass would be considered for applicability. If however, the facility is subject to the rule, all emissions from the combustion of biomass fuels are required to be reported.
