HOW TO APPLY FOR CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND FINANCING

New projects applying for funds through the State Water Board's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Program.

- 1) Get on the CWSRF Program's Project Priority List (PPL), by completing the State Water Board's on-line Financial Assistance Application Submittal Tool (FAAST) application. Instructions regarding the FAAST application process are available at the following web address:
