The Organization: The Union Sanitary District (USD) is an award-winning, innovative independent wastewater district in the Tri-cities of Fremont, Newark, and Union City in southern Alameda County. In 2013, the District treated an average dry weather flow of 26 MGD and has a total average dry weather capacity of 33 MGD. The District has a staff of 141.

The Position: The Treatment and Disposal Services Manager is an at-will position that reports to the General Manager and fulfills the role of Chief Plant Operator ensuring that all wastewater is treated in compliance with federal, state, and local regulations and that the District's wastewater treatment plant and related facilities are operated in a safe, efficient, and cost-effective manner. The T & D Services Manager participates as a member of the USD Executive Team in District-wide strategic planning and policy activities and is a resource to the Board of Directors and General Manager on technical and management programs.

Requirements: Completion of four years' college with major coursework in environmental engineering or a closely related field and several years of increasingly responsible supervisory or managerial experience in wastewater treatment, with at least two years at a level comparable to or higher than a Coach at Union Sanitary District. Must possess a Grade V California Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator's Certificate.
