The Organization: The Union Sanitary District (USD) is an award-winning, innovative independent wastewater district in the Tri-cities of Fremont, Newark, and Union City in southern Alameda County. In 2013, the District treated an average dry weather flow of 22 MGD and has a total average dry weather capacity of 33 MGD. The District has a staff of 142.

The Position: The Wastewater Operations Coach plans, organizes, supervises, and directs overall plant operations and routine maintenance and cleaning of the District's wastewater treatment plant and related facilities during the night shift (noon to 9:30 pm) on a 9/80 work schedule with every other Monday off. The incumbent participates in an on-call rotation and may work weekends and off-shifts based on operational needs.

The Wastewater Operations Coach supports and works effectively in a team-based organization, carrying out technical, coaching, supervisory, project management, and administrative responsibilities. The Coach plays a critical role in carrying out the District's Strategic Plan and contributes to the success of the District's mission. This position requires the ability to exercise a high degree of independent judgment and effective decision-making, communication, and interpersonal skills.

Requirements: Completion of two years' college and five years of increasingly responsible experience in the operation, maintenance, and cleaning of a wastewater treatment plant and related facilities. One year of experience in a lead capacity and/or additional education related to wastewater operations, business, or supervision in the public sector are highly desirable. Additional experience can substitute for some or all of the college requirement. Must possess a Grade IV California Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator's Certificate.
