

#### **Frightening Chemical Statistics**

- Every day the United States uses or imports about 42 million pounds of synthetic chemicals
- In 2008, 162 million pounds of <u>reported</u> pesticides were applied in CA
- In 2008, over 324 million prescriptions were filled at retail pharmacies in CA
  - That's almost 10 billion pills

#### **Frightening Chemical Statistics**

- More than 700 OTC medicines use ingredients and dosages that were available only by prescription less than 30 years ago.
- There are approximately 1,000 active ingredients used in the more than 100,000 OTC products available in the marketplace.



- The law of the conservation of matter: matter cannot be created or destroyed
- All those chemicals are going to reside somewhere in our environment.

#### **POTW Treatment Technology**

- Most POTWs employ 1970's treatment technology established by the Clean Water Act.
- POTWs were designed in the 1970's to remove pollutants typical of that era.
- Since that time, there have been millions of new chemicals synthesized.


# Common Sense Tells Us

Pharmaceuticals

Personal care products

- Antibacterial agents (Triclosan)
- Pyrethroid pesticides
  - Result of product substitution
- Flame retardants
- Plasticizers
  - Phthalates, Bisphenol A

#### CECs in Wastewater

- CECs are present in minute concentrations throughout the wastewater treatment process
  - Influent, effluent, solids, recycled water
- Because of this, the issue of CECs is being addressed by most BACWA Committees
