SUBJECT: New Requirement to Report Monitoring Information to eSMR/CIWQS

This letter outlines a new requirement for wastewater permittees to report monitoring information electronically to a statewide system, the Electronic Self-Monitoring Report (eSMR). The eSMR is a module within the California Integrated Water Quality System (CIWQS), which is one of the Water Boards' primary information management systems. The eSMR system has been and is currently being implemented in other regions throughout the State. The information afflected by this requirement includes data and information currently required by NPDES permits to be submitted in routine self-monitoring reports. Permittees who currently report to the regional Electronic Reporting System (ERS) will need to transition into eSMR, because we plan to discontinue using ERS for monitoring data in 2012.

The attached table summarizes the steps for implementing eSMR for major permittees in 2011. We divided the permittees into four roughly equal-sized groups with the largest permittees and those not currently reporting to ERS in the first group. Also considered was the permit reissuance time frame to avoid conflict. The general plan is for the first group to start submitting monitoring information to eSMR by the end of the first calendar quarter, with subsequent groups in subsequent quarters. Any permittee who desires to implement earlier then its assigned group may do so.

Please complete and submit the attached reply form no later than the date listed in the table. The purpose of the form is to indicate that you have received and understand this letter, and to list staff assigned to implement eSMR for your district, municipality, agency, company, or coorporation so that we will have a complete contacts list for all relevant future communications.

The next step involves a training workshop by State Water Board eSMR staff near the beginning of each quarter. All permittees are welcomed and encouraged to attend the first training workshop, but only Group 1 is required to attend. Permittees in subsequent groups are required to attend the group workshop that is scheduled for their assigned group. The group workshop will be followed by individual training as needed or desired. We expect permittees to register with eSMR fairly soon after the workshop, and to start reporting monitoring information to eSMR soon after that, but no later than the dates indicated in the attached table. Initially, permittees will report both through eSMR and their current system (paper or ERS). We will review and compare the information submitted. If there are inconsistencies or missing data, we

will notify the permittee. If the information is complete and accurate for at least 3 months, permittees will receive permission to report just to eSMR.

This new eSMR requirement is necessary so that all monitoring information will be in one system administered by the State Water Board. This change may require some permittees to modernize their information systems to facilitate electronic reporting. Also, for those permittees in ERS, there will be some loss in functionality going from ERS to eSMR. We understand that implementation of new requirements will be challenging for some permittees. It will be challenging for us as well. However, this change must occur. We look forward to working with you and associations like the Bay Area Clean Water Agencies to overcome the challenges and successfully implement eSMR.
