This is the lead class in the professional civil engineering classification series. Engineers in this class provide lead supervision, perform the more difficult or complex civil engineering work and exercise a greater latitude of independent judgment. Incumbents in this class often serve as project leader on major civil engineering projects. Assignments may be in the field of structural, water resource, sanitary, water systems, control systems or geotechnical engineering.
