Furthermore, no additional Preliminary Risk Assessment or Drinking Water Assessment will be conducted by EFED because of the limited potential for environmental exposure to amitraz from these uses."	EPA should do down-the-drain assessments for all pet collar products to determine if risk mitigation is necessary.
