EPA Proposed Label Clarifications – Pictograms, Stewardship Statement, and Spanish Language – Support with Modifications- BACWA supports the concept of a graphic showing an image of an "X" – or better the "do not" symbol– over a drain on product packages. We have extensive experience with regard to graphically communicating "do not discharge" to various audiences and have found this approach to be very effective, if the graphic is properly designed. We appreciate EPA's example (shown to the right) but cannot support the use of the EPA graphic due to lack of clarity, particularly when the image is reduced in size to fit on smaller packaging. We request that EPA please select a clear, schematic graphic that is very obvious as to what is prohibited. We would be pleased to work with EPA, our national association NACWA, and registrants toward selecting an appropriate graphic. To ensure that these label elements completely and effectively address products that may be discharged "down-the-drain" into municipal wastewater collection systems, we request that EPA modify the "label table" in Appendix B to: 1.
