

 - Inventory Worker (1)




City's Recycled Water Program

- The program started in the early 1960s.
- Serves Zone 1 of Livermore Municipal Water Area
- Over 19 miles of pipelines to serve 52 users with 160 permanent connections.
- Landscape irrigation, fire protection, and dual plumbed uses.
- Mono-media filtration (5 gpm/sf or 2.6 mgd/filter) followed by UV disinfection.
- Two off-site tanks for storage (4 MG total)
- 35% of total influent is recycled
